*We offer pre and post camp to all campers free of charge. Campers participating in pre and post camp must be dropped off and picked up from the Eagle Point camp site.*

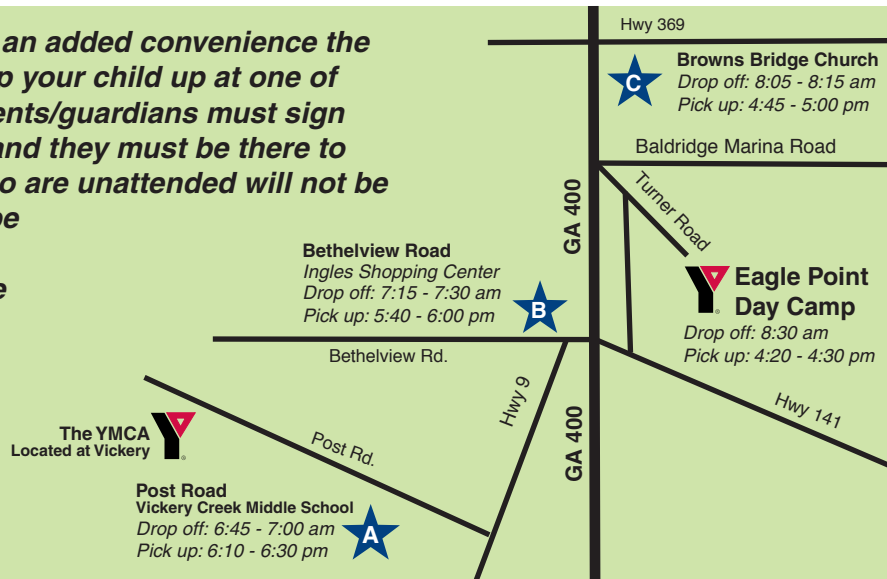
## ***Camps:*** (Based upon age of child while attending camp)

5-6 years:	Rising Stars
7-8 years:	Hot Shots
9-10 years:	Soaring Eagles
11-12 years:	Flying Aces



Take advantage of the three bus routes. As an added convenience the YMCA is providing transportation to pick up your child up at one of three locations. For your child's safety parents/guardians must sign your children in as they load onto the bus and they must be there to sign them out as they off load. Children who are unattended will not be picked up by our bus service not will they be allowed off of the bus without an approved parent/guardian there to sign them out. The fee for this service is \$40 per session.

## For Your Convenience *Bus Route:*



The **Rising Stars, ages 5-6** program is an excellent first time camp experience. Our goal is to create an atmosphere of trust and friendship so that your child will feel happy and confident during the entire day at camp. We place children in small groups, a ration of 1 counselor to 6 kids, in order to insure that they receive individualized attention. Activities include: Supervised recreational swimming, Nature Activities, Group Games, Arts & Crafts, Songs, Story Time, Archery, and more.



The **Hot Shots, ages 7-8** program is a progressive camp that allows children in this age group to explore more challenging traditional camp activities while maintaining a 1:12 ration counselor/camper ratio. Activities include: Supervised Recreational Swimming, Nature Activities, Group Games, Arts-n-Crafts, Skits & Songs, Fishing, Kayaking, and more.



The **Soaring Eagles, age 9-10** program provides a variety of new challenges for camper's ages 9 to 10 of age. Soaring Eagle campers are encouraged to work and challenge themselves to achieve a higher level of success by participating in a number of activities. Counselors and campers work side by side as they participate together in learning new skills. Activities include: Supervised Recreational Swimming, Nature Activities, Group Games, Arts & Crafts, Skits & Songs, Fishing, Canoeing, Kayaking, Archery and more.



The **Flying Aces, age 11-12** program is designed to encourage campers to soar and experience camp at its highest levels. This progressive program is geared to challenge the Flying Aces to work together with their fellow campers to form a team. They accomplish this through a variety of group focused activities that enable camper and staff to work hand-in-hand through each session to build lasting friendships and memories. Activities include: Supervised Recreational Swimming, Nature Activities, Group Games, Arts & Crafts, Skits & Songs, Fishing, Canoeing, Kayaking, Archery, Assisting in opening and closing assemblies and more.
