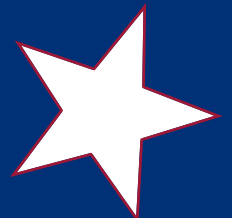

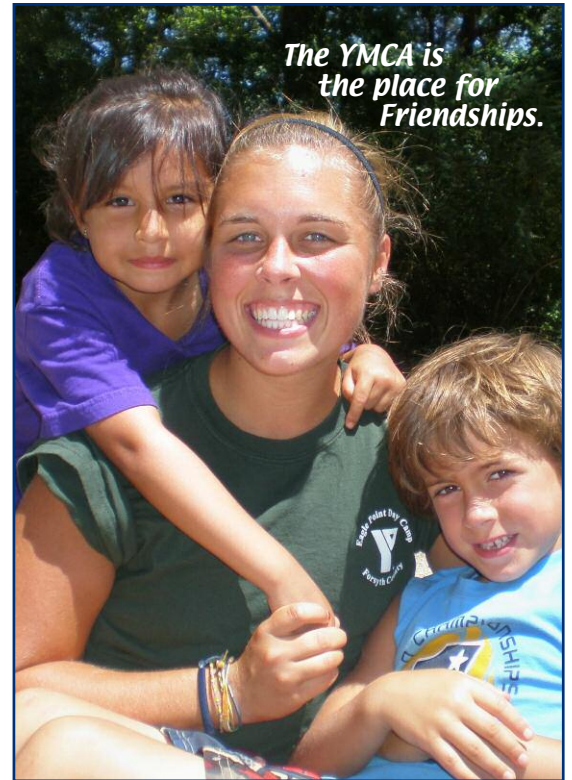

Camp Pruett Important Information

YMCA Mission: Your YMCA, reflecting its Judeo-Christian heritage, is an association of volunteers, members and staff open to and serving all, providing programs and services which develop spirit, mind and body. Financial assistance is available based on need. The YMCA actively seeks to identify and involve those in need.

Registration Procedures:

- Membership (Program or Facility) is due at the time of registration, unless your membership is current and extends through the camp week of choice.
- **Immunization Form 3231 must be submitted with registration. A new form must be submitted each year. Registration will not be processed without the form.**
- A separate registration form for each child is required. One completed form per child is required. The form may be photocopied. Provide all information requested, including your signature and initialing on payment policies on the registration form. **Incomplete registration forms will be sent back to you to complete** and may not be processed until filled out completely.
- **You may register in person, by mail, or fax. YMCA fax number: 770-345-5290. Please provide your email address on your fax.** Faxed registrations will receive an email receipt within 7 days. After 7 days, please call 770-345-9622.
- Faxed registrations require payment by credit card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express). Please fill out and sign the credit card authorization form.
- Please make checks payable to: YMCA and include your child's name on the check.
- Registration closes at noon the Wednesday before each program starts or when the camp is full.
- A NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT of \$20 per child per week is due at the time of registration. If registering less than 3 weeks in advance, payment is due in full at the time of registration.
- Payment Balance is due in full on the Friday 3 weeks prior to the start of each camp. Payment must be received by the date to confirm your child's reservation. If you have an unpaid balance your child will not be allowed to attend any further camps until the balance is paid in full.
- To add a camp program, fill out an addition form and make a payment at the front desk. (An addition form can be picked up at the front desk or we can fax/email one to you). **Additions can not be taken over the phone.**



Cancellation Policy:

- Cancellations must be made in writing on a Cancellation Form. Return cancellation forms to the YMCA Office.
- If a cancellation is made 3 weeks before the registered week, the non-refundable deposit will be forfeited and the balance will be refunded.
- If a cancellation is made less than 3 weeks before the registered week, all monies paid will be forfeited.
- If a cancellation form is not filled out 3 weeks prior to the start of camps and your child does not attend camp, you will be responsible for the balance.

Transfer Information:

- You may transfer from one camp to another ONLY within the week that you are already registered.
- Transfer into another camp will be granted upon availability.
- Transfer requests must be made in writing 1 week prior to the start of the registered week.
- You may not transfer from one week to another week. This requires cancellation of one registered week and addition to another week.
