### Program Philosophy

The YMCA after school program is designed to respond to the diverse developmental needs of children, including rest and nourishment which is centrally important. To meet children's personal growth needs the staff role is to facilitate an environment that is not over directed but empowering, which will foster children's independence by encouraging them to make friends, tryout new experiences, and think of new ideas. We believe that children's intellectual needs are met when opportunities are provided for them to safely explore their personal interests through carefully enriched and challenging activities monitored by the staff.

**Program Statement:** To qualify for enrollment, children must be able to function in a small group setting to ensure the safety and well-being of all children.

### Hours of Operation

Prime time begins at school closing and continues until 6:30 p.m. Our program operates on site every day that school is in session, weather permitting.

### Holiday Camp

On Winter and Spring breaks the East Lake Family YMCA will be offering full day Holiday Camp at an alternate location. These full day programs will have an additional fee. Holiday Camp is held from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Cost is \$20.00 per day per child. Space is limited on a first-come, first-served basis.

### Fees

A safe and reliable after school program doesn't have to cost a fortune. Prime Time is affordable for everyone. The week fee is \$65.00 per child. Each child must have a Facility or Program Membership to register. Annual Program Membership cost: \$25.00-individual; \$35.00-family. The YMCA actively seeks to identify families needing financial assistance. Please call the YMCA to apply for our Partner With Youth scholarship applications. **Scholarship funds are limited, so apply early.**

### AT THE EAST LAKE FAMILY YMCA

Enrollment information may be picked up at the East Lake Family YMCA Membership Services Desk. Enrollment packets may not be picked up prior to open registration. Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis and spaces are limited.

The complete registration packet, the annual \$25.00 non-refundable program member registration fee and payment for the first week's tuition must be completed. Facility members pay weekly fee. You must provide proof of income in order to have your weekly fees based on the sliding scale fee. In the form of 2 current check stubs from the head(s) of the household. Failure to provide required forms and payment may exclude your child(ren) from participation.

- All children must be registered at the YMCA before they can attend.
- Part-time Prime Time is not available.
- The Prime Time program is not a drop-in childcare service.
