Sign In/Sign Out Policy

Parents signing their child into the Nursery must first scan their Y membership card. Parents must remain on the premises while their child is in the Nursery. Children may only be signed-out by the same parent or guardian who signed-in the child. If your child cries or seems distressed for more than ten minutes, we will come and get you so that you may come and help your child.

Snacks

The YMCA cannot be responsible for preparing formulas or serving meals to the children in our care. We furnish saltines and ask that no other food be brought in. This is for the safety of your children. You may bring in baby bottles and sippy cups for babies, but please mark them well. You may also bring in juice for your children but it must be in a spill-proof cup with a lid.

Belongings

If the child is not completely potty trained, he or she needs to be in a diaper or pull-up. Diapers and wipes for each child should be supplied by the parent. Please label all bags and diapers. Pacifiers must be attached to the child's clothing with a pacifier pal or the like. Personal toys are very difficult to keep up with in the nursery and we suggest you keep them at home. All children **MUST** be wearing socks (infants) or shoes/socks.

Illness/Contagious Conditions

Any child who appears to have any illness or contagious condition including but not limited to- cold or cough, diarrhea or vomiting, nasal or ear discharge, fever, contagious rashes (chicken pox, impetigo, fifth's disease) or head lice- will be asked to be removed from our nursery. The child cannot return until he/she is symptom free or has a doctor's note stating that the child is not contagious. In any case, sick children should not return for 48 hours. YMCA staff will not distribute medication.

Time Out

This is the only form of discipline used in our nursery. Any child who bites another child or shows aggressive behavior will be suspended for two weeks. The YMCA expects members and guests to behave in an appropriate manner. Inappropriate behavior such as the use of foul language, dangerous play or fighting is unacceptable and may result in the termination of your membership privileges. Members will be held responsible for the conduct of any guests they bring to the YMCA.
