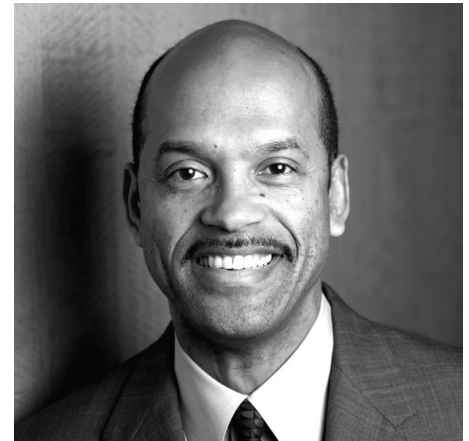

## Joseph A. Arnold elected Board Chairman

Joe is senior vice president and manager of SunTrust Atlanta's Not-For-Profit and Government Banking division. This group and its cross-LOB teammates provide banking services including credit, depository, treasury management, capital markets, trust, etc., to 501(c) and governmental entities, including large public and private educational institutions, municipalities, state government agencies, foundations, and associations.

A Metro Atlanta YMCA board member since 2001, he has served as treasurer, finance and audit committee chairman, and executive committee member. Joe embodies stewardship, and he takes the role of overseeing the Y's operations very seriously. He incorporates the best practices of nonprofits to ensure our standards continue at the highest possible level.

"The Y is the nation's leading nonprofit committed to strengthening communities through youth development, healthy living and social responsibility," says Joe. "In Atlanta, we work side-by-side with our neighbors to make sure everyone, regardless of age, income or background, has the opportunity to learn, grow and connect.
